Have you ever seen a political party convention? It can be seen there that the top leader of that political party is the main speaker. He was the last to arrive at the venue. Before his arrival, the regional leaders of his party, along with the leaders and workers of their respective regions, arrived in a procession and waited for the arrival of the top leader. They then communicate with the top leader or his assistants and repeatedly announce the exact time of the leader's arrival. Moments before his arrival, the arrival message is announced over the loudspeaker, and he is welcomed on stage with cheers. Then, the proceedings of the meeting begin, and his speech is heard like a spell. They try to implement it literally. The same is happening with religious leaders. Allah has sent prophets and messengers throughout the ages to keep people on the right path. Whether their number was one hundred and twenty-six thousand or two hundred and twenty-six thousand, only 25 are named in the Qur'an. All of them, except Muhammad, were sent to their own community for that time and region for that time. Most of them received the Sahifa (a number of principles for walking in the way of God), and four received the Book of God. To Musa, the Torah, to David (a.s) the Psalms, to Jesus (a.s) the Gospel, and to Muhammad(s) Al Quran were revealed. The Torah, Psalms, Gospel and other scriptures foretell the coming of Muhammad(s). It is indeed significant and clearly indicates that Muhammad(s) is to be obeyed after his arrival. Therefore, in order

to touch the young minds of this evolution of religion, I am briefly presenting the religions of the past and the religion of Muhammad(s).

But you must remember that the religion that has been passed down since the creation of man is the same religion of the same God, Islam, which means submission to the will of God.
